Nursery School

During the Autumn term the children have showed us their continued interest in mark-making. They have completed self-portraits, drawings of their families and observational drawings of autumn leaves and a bicycle wheel. We have explored 2D shapes and have been noticing them all around the Nursery. We will move onto 3D shapes shortly. The children have begun to explore traditional tales beginning with *The 3 Billy Goats Gruff* and *the Gingerbread Man*. Children have been very excited to make and cook their own gingerbread man. Each colour group has had the opportunity to explore a new space in the garden studio for movement, music and relaxation. Matt the artist has returned to set up a new atelier space in the garden studio. He is going to spend some time introducing the space and the found materials with each colour group soon.

In music and movement with Lizzy the children have been exploring Diwali style dancing. They have been listening and testing out moves and they are working towards a simple choreographed routine. Forest School has started in the second half of the Autumn term. We have been learning about the different rules that we need to learn to keep ourselves safe in the Forest School environment.

Nurture Nursery

During the second half of the Autumn term children have been introduced to a range of found materials (tubes, lids, cylinders, strings of beads of different lengths, boxes with lids, bottles etc.) to explore and develop open-ended play opportunities. There has been great interest in the materials with particular focus on posting, connecting, filling & emptying and also lots of opportunity to develop mathematical language around shape, space, measures and counting. Through these learning opportunities staff have observed lots of 'characteristics of effective learning' as the children develop their own ideas, test out their ideas and begin to share their ideas with each other.

This half term a rolling group time has been introduced where the children take it in turns in their colour group with their key worker to participate in a small group session in the entrance. The focus has been on movement and action songs and the children have responded well to this extra group time.

Teacher Trainees

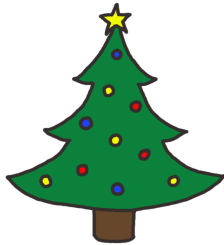
