Nursery School Parent Consultations

We're delighted with the way children have settled in and will now be undertaking parent consultations on Tuesday 12th (Red and Green Groups) and Wednesday 13th (Blue and Orange groups) November. These are a chance for you to be updated on your child's progress in Nursery School so far, and ask any questions you may have. You can nominate your chosen slot by filling in the relevant grids which are up on the parent noticeboard in the main reception. Slots are 10 minutes long and we thank you in advance for helping Colour Group Leaders in keeping to time. If there are any worries or concerns that require a more in depth discussion then a separate parent/Colour Group Leader meeting can be arranged separately from the parent consultations.

Big thank you for voluntary contributions to our School Fund

We'd like to extend our sincere thanks on behalf of the Nursery School, our staff and Governors, to all of you who have kindly made voluntary contributions to us. Your donations so far have enabled us to buy the time of our artist in residence for 8 days of over the academic year. These days will take place during November and March, and will directly impact children's creative learning process. Without your support this would not be possible, so thank you for making a difference at a time when Maintained Nursery School budgets are under huge funding pressures that result in real term cuts.

Maintained Nursery Schools (MNS) funding update

We are delighted that the Department of Education have again recognised the importance and value of Maintained Nursery Schools nationally, committing to continuing the supplementary funding they provide for us until summer 2021, by which time a full funding decision should be made. Nick Gibb wrote a ministerial statement "I can confirm today that supplementary funding for Maintained Nursery Schools (MNS) will continue, at its current rate, for the whole of the 2020-21 financial year. I can also confirm that the government remains committed to funding for MNS in the longer term; and that any reform to the way they are funded in future will be accompanied with funding protections." This funding recognises that Maintained Nursery Schools (MNS) are unique in their offer, structure and value, and supports us to be able to fulfil all of our school duties and requirements. Most importantly, allowing us to retain our educational provision with qualified Headteachers and Teachers with full QTS who have specialised in educating this age group leading the work in our schools.

We now have over 100 MPs working in an 'all party parliamentary group' (APPG) alongside the national group Early Education and the Nursery Headteachers, supporting the work on future funding for MNS. We are delighted that despite the uncertainty of the times that we continue to be recognised and valued for our excellence and vital contribution to early childhood education.
