The children used their photographs on the iPad to draw a side view self-portrait which was very tricky and really challenges their perceived view of what their face should look like.

After Easter we will continue to post a weekly activity.

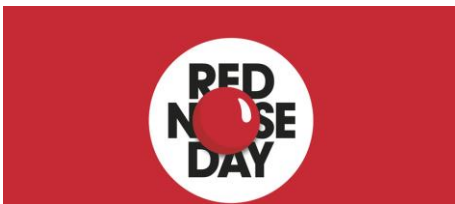


Living Eggs
