Main Nursery

A big 'thank you' to parents for all your support with the photos you have been sending in to school showing the bean plants the children have been growing at home, and also the photos of the children as babies.

The children have been excited to share their photos and have the opportunity to talk about these in their colour groups. This had led to lots of work around height and measuring as the children have explored the growth of both their plants and themselves. Adults have encouraged children to 'notice' and talk about the changes they have observed and this has led to many stories, discussion and exploration around growth and change. This focus has also led to lots of storytelling and adults have scribed the children's ideas as they have told their stories.

Woodwork has continued to fascinate and inspire the children and this term they have been learning different techniques to fix and join their work. We have also begun to work together on longer pieces of wood. Thank you for the wood offcuts that have been brought in for the children to work on and thank you to all our parent volunteers who have helped Leesa in Forest School and with the woodwork.
