Nursery School

Welcome to the spring term here at Kenilworth Nursery, and welcome to all our new starters! We're delighted with the way children are settling so far this term and are excited to be offering new activities for returning children to enjoy including Forest School Activities on Monday and Wednesday mornings, woodwork on Tuesdays and literacy on Fridays. Please be assured that themes in literacy will be continued in group time throughout the week, so all children will access the literacy curriculum. Other weekly activities include music and movement, relaxation and yoga so the children have plenty to enjoy here with us this term!

Living Eggs Spring term fundraiser

As a part of our enhanced curriculum provision we'd love to offer children in the Nursery School the chance to take part in the wonderful 'Living Eggs' project we run each year in the spring term. This is an ethical chick hatching project which involves 'live' incubated eggs being bought into the school for two weeks, and during that time children will get to see the chicks hatch and grow! Children will get the chance to hold the chicks and to undertake lots of creative activities around the subject of 'growth and change'. It's a very special experience for everyone and we've received incredibly positive feedback about it from parents/carers in the past. Regretfully, this activity will only be made possible by parental donations and we therefore kindly ask that you consider making a cash or BACS donation to the school fund for this purpose. The cost of the 'Living Eggs' is £300 and if every family donated, it would cost £5.50 per child. Donations can be made via the School Office Manager in main reception, and will need to please be made by February half-term in order for us to book in time. If you

haven't already, please also fill out a gift aid declaration if you are an income tax payer, as this will enable the school to claim an extra 25p on top of any donations we receive. Staff and Governors extend our sincere thanks for any support you can give us, at a time when Maintained Nursery School budgets are under huge funding pressures that result in real-time cuts.

Children's illness, holidays and collections

If your child is going to be absent from Nursery School due to infection or illness, please call the office on 01926 853394 on the first day of absence. Similarly, if you are planning to be away on holiday please let us know. Finally, if you plan to have someone other than a parent/carer collect your child please let us know, and we will put a collection password in place for you, and record your permission having been granted. Keeping your children safe is our top priority so if you forget to do this, we will call you to confirm that you authorise collection, and won't let your child go until permission has been given. We will also call you in the case of unauthorised absences. Many thanks for your understanding and support of this process to ensure that all our children are safe.
