## **EY Lead Practitioner Role**

This is a specialist role for those in a non-teacher position. As an EYLP you will be sharing your Early Years expertise and experience with colleagues in other settings to support EYs practice. This is an exciting opportunity to play a supportive role in your wider educational community and to develop your own Professional Development

## What would this involve?

Following a successful application and interview process, you would be asked to visit other EYs providers who are seeking support. You will also be asked to assist with our EY Aspiration Networks and the creation/delivery of training to support the sector. The frequency of the work would be subject to local demand and would be agreed by your Manager/Headteacher. To remain designated as an EYLP you would need to complete at least 1 piece of work within 2 academic years.



## Is this a paid position?

The role is not salaried, but WEYH would cover the cost of your time out by paying your setting/school an agreed daily supply rate.
