Main Nursery

In Main Nursery the children have been settling into school life, learning about the routines of the session and exploring all the different areas and resources in the environment. Particular areas of interest have been around block play and using found resources to create three dimensional structures. Last week we invited all the children to do a self-portrait, firstly looking in the mirror and talking about what features they noticed before making representational marks. The children have been excited to explore the autumn collections in school, including collecting leaves from around the garden, looking at and describing a selection of pumpkins in the Curiosity Cube and using a range of resources for rolling conkers.

Nurture Nursery

This half term the children have been fascinated by the autumn collections that have been available for them to explore. Not only using their senses to explore, they have used the conkers to experiment with rolling down the guttering. They have also been using the wooden trucks to transport items around the Nurture Nursery garden. Other interests have been bathing the babies in the bubbly water, taking care in handling them, bathing and then drying the babies. A further area of interest has been the use of the magnetic shapes for creating patterns and pictures.

Clothing reminders

As the weather is getting colder and wetter, please bring a coat for your child, ensuring that it's clearly named. To encourage independence, please make sure that you send children in to School in shoes that they can take off and put on by themselves.

Side entrance

If you're in the Main Nursery in Red or Green group and you arrive later than 9.10am, please use the main entrance so Emily can let you in. We're often in the middle of group time or outside, so are not able to answer the door.

Children's absence, holidays and collections

If your child is unwell and going to be absent from Nursery School, please call 01926 853394 or email kenilworthnsoffice@welearn365.com on the first day of absence. We're required to follow up all absences so please help us by letting Emily in the office know. Similarly, if you're planning to be away on holiday please contact us. Finally, if you plan to have someone other than a parent/carer collect your child please let us know, and we will put a collection password in place for you, and record your permission having been granted. Keeping your children safe is our top priority.

Labelling

Please make sure that your child's name is on all clothing and hats.

Can you also please put your child's name on the outside of their bags, and lunch boxes.

Toileting accidents

If your child has an accident whilst at nursery, we'll place their wet clothes in a bag and give it to you at the end of your child's session. Please make sure a new set of clean clothes is brought back in.

Voluntary contributions

Parents have been wonderfully generous over the last few years in supporting the school's Voluntary Contribution Fund, which has enabled us to purchase extra resources for the children that would otherwise have been impossible. Your support is very much appreciated and does make a difference as it buys the fruit the children eat and contributes in many other ways too!

Lunch Club Guidance

These are just a few reminders:

- We encourage children to be able to open their own lunchboxes and packaging on their food. So only bring food they can open themselves.
- Please send your child with a healthy lunch no chocolate or sweets.
- Name lunch bags on the outside; please also name any Tupperware boxes.
- Grapes and small sausages must be cut up lengthways as there have been a number of incidents in the media of children choking on them.
- Children should not bring their own drinks including smoothies; all children are provided with milk or water.
- Utensils such as spoons for yoghurts or forks need to be included in their lunchbox.
- NO NUTS INCLUDING ANY SNACK/CAKE BARS CONTAINING NUTS or CHOCOLATE SPREAD

You will need to apply for a place in Reception for September 2023 if your child was born between 1 September 2018 and 31 August 2019. You can apply from 1 November 2022 and you must apply for their Reception place by **5pm on 15 January 2023**.
