Nurture Nursery

With a number of new children settling into Nurture Nursery we have kept the environment and routines very familiar this half term. Outside we have introduced more 'small world' play with a safari, following the interests we have seen from some of our established children. There has been great interest indoors and outdoors in mark making. Outside we have used white chalks on black paper and lots of paint brushes with water to make both large and small detailed marks. Children are responding well to large pieces of paper they can collaboratively make marks on. Inside the whole table has been covered with white paper and has been filled with colourful marks across the morning. We are now planning to extend this interest in mark making next half term.

We are delighted to welcome some new members of staff to our Nurture Nursery team. Anna Fennell-McLoughlin started in Nurture Nursery this week as our new Early Years Educator

She is a fully qualified teacher and brings with her a strong interest in the early education of young children. The children have responded to her immediately and she is now building really lovely relationships for learning with them.

In addition, each Thursday and Friday for the summer term we will also welcome Lauren Patel, again a fully qualified teacher who has made a choice to come and work with us so she can specialise in early years and will work alongside. Lauren will again provide some individual support work.

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Development work for the Teaching Team this term

Resourcing stories to include sensory motor learning in our story time experiences. As we look for more ways to include all children, including those with different learning styles, in our activities we have started some development work as a team to bring story times to life with increased sensory motor participation. We will also be talking to the children about our 'energy' for learning and will think about how ready we might be to learn and what we can do to prepare ourselves.
